Bad weather holds up Mansarovar pilgrims

In Simikot, Embassy has pressed into a service a medical team to check the health condition of the pilgrims. The Mission is also looking at various alternative routes for evacuation. Local airlines operating on the route have been asked to ensure availability of extra aircraft in Nepalgunj to have maximum number of sorties as soon as the weather clears up. Praveen Prakash, resident commissioner of AP Bhavan said, the Mission was also looking at the possibility of heli-evacuation for critical cases, quoting an Embassy staffer.

Those stuck included 60 pilgrims from Telangana at India- Nepal border due to heavy rains and bad weather. All of them were on pilgrimage to Mansarovar. Officials said they were safe and efforts are on to shift them to safer places.

On the instructions of Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrababhu Naidu, the officials of Telangana Bhavan and special representatives of state government in New Delhi swung into action to rescue the stranded pilgrims with the help of defence forces.

Telangana special representative

in Delhi S Venugopala Chary said that the stranded pilgrims were from Khammam, Nalgonda, Rangareddy, Hyderabad and Mahabubnagar. All of them are safe. They are being provided with drinking water, food and medicines through choppers.

After airlifting them to the national capital, Chary said a special flight, if required, will be arranged to send the pilgrims to Hyderabad. It will take at least 24 hours to reach the stranded pilgrims. He said the Chief Minister is closely monitoring the situation with the officials of Telangana Bhavan.

Meanwhile, Andhra pilgrims, who went to Kailash Mansarovar continued to suffer due to inclement weather conditions for the second consecutive day on Tuesday as the Nepalese authorities could not operate helicopters and flights to airlift to these pilgrims to safer place Nepalgunj, which is connecting to India.

Nearly 100 Telugu pilgrims stranded at Hilsar, Simikot in Nepal, according to information collected by state government officials. These pilgrims were stranded at Hilsar and Simikot while returning from Mansarovar.

It is estimated that about 1,575 Indian pilgrims are stranded in Nepal since Monday. Minister for External Affairs Sushma in a tweet on Tuesday said: "Indian pilgrims stranded in Nepal - There are about 525 pilgrims stranded in Simikot, 550 in Hilsa and another 500 in Tibet side."

Most pilgrims had no medicine and shelter till Tuesday afternoon. The local authorities have arranged rooms for the stay in Hilsar, said Uggu Muralikrishna, one of the pilgrims from Vijayawada. He along with his brother Uggu Koteswara Rao went to Mansarovar on June 25 and struck on Monday in the return journey. Muralikrishna was in touch with the family members since Monday and giving information about the food, medicine and shelter available to the pilgrims.

K Vinod a family member of Muralikrishna, said his uncle had taken solar phone, which became very handy in difficult situations in Nepal.

Since Hilsar and Simikot located in remote areas, the Nepalese authorities are also facing some difficulties to provide basic amenities.

If normal weather conditions return, the Nepalese authorities can

operate choppers and flights to airlift the stranded pilgrims.

Chandrababu Naidu held an emergency meeting on the Nepal tragedy on Tuesday through Real Time Governance and directed officials concerned to initiate necessary action to help the Telugu pilgrims.

He directed the officials to send special teams to Nepal to assist the Telugu people to come back to the state. The higher officials of the Andhra Pradesh government are in touch with the AP Bhavan authorities in New Delhi and collecting information about the stranded pilgrims and their safety. Dr Arja Srikanth, Additional Commissioner at AP Bhavan, New Delhi, informed that the Special Team will leave from AP Bhavan on Wednesday. The team will land at Nepalgunj which is a Sub-Metropolitan City in Banke District, Nepal.

As the Nepal government established base camp for stranded pilgrims at Nepalgunj, state government is also deploying the Special Team there. This team will help the stranded pilgrims for the safe return to their homes. The AP Government is in continuous contact with the Indian Embassy in Nepal.

400 landlords not to get Rythu Bandhu sops

The officials said that the State Revenue and Agriculture department which conducted land purification programme to verify the ownership of the lands for the distribution of new pattadar pass-books found many farmers registered land in their names, but mutation was still pending. Taking advantage of the loopholes in the Revenue department which is the authority to do mutations, farmers violated the Land Ceiling Act and possessed huge acres of land.

As per the official records, 62 per cent of farmers in Telangana possessed less than 2.5 acres of land, 24 per cent own the land between 2.5 acres and 5 acres, 11 per cent peasants own between 5 acres and 10 acres, less than 3 per cent own between 10 acres and 25 acres and 0.88 per cent of the farmers own more than 25 acres of land. The statistics did not reveal the total number of farmers who owned land more than 52 acres. The government is expected to take a decision on resumption of excess land from the big farmers sooner than later. As per the Ceiling Act, the big farmers will have to surrender the excess lands to the government. If not, the government is authorised to cancel the ownership.

The Union Home Ministry recently drafted a new set of guidelines on the Prime Minister's security.

Officials said there was "an all-time high" threat to the Prime Minister and described him as the "most valuable target" in the run-up to the 2019 general elections.

Governance: A government has to play the role of an enabler and not an obstructer, the prime minister said. "We have translated this philosophy into action over the last four years. Technology plays an important role in achieving this aim," Modi said. The end objective of 'Minimum Government, Maximum Governance' is to make the lives of people hassle-free, he added.

Air India disinvestment: Modi said his government doesn't want to be accused of selling something cheaply and the government has pursued Air India's divestment "with utmost sincerity". "We don't want to make a sale where we will be accused of selling something for X amount when we could have got more," he said.

Employment: The government has created more than 41 lakh formal jobs from September 2017 to April 2018 based on EPFO payroll data.

He also highlighted that the old way of measuring jobs is not good enough to measure new jobs in the country.

PSU banks: "We had identified the problem with banks in 2014 itself," Modi said. The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) had helped in reducing loans gone bad, he said, adding that many businessmen have had to lose their companies for failing to pay bank dues.

Internal Security: The Prime Minister assured that the government's strategy for internal security is showing the result in the Maoist-affected areas, and in Kashmir, the focus will be on "good governance, development, and accountability."

Ease of doing business: All the existing labour laws are being simplified, rationalised and amalgamated into four labour codes, Modi said. "Processes for incorporating a company have been simplified and it is now possible to get it done in 24 hours," he said.

States cannot appoint acting DGP: SC

Any rule or state law on the subject of appointment of police officers "will be kept at abeyance", it said as the Centre pointed out that states were appointing their "favourite" police officers as DGPs.

The verdict came almost 12 years after the Supreme Court issued a series of directions on police reforms on a PIL filed by former UP DGP Prakash Singh. It had ordered setting up of a state security commission to ensure that the government does not exercise unwarranted influence on the police and recommended fixed two-year tenure for DGPs and Police Superintendents.

The bench, which also included Justice AM Khanwilkar and Justice DY Chandrachud, said endeavour should be to select an officer having reasonable period of service left for appointment as DGP. However, it said states which have made laws on police appointments were free to seek modification of its order.

Tuesday's directions of the top court came on pleas, including that of the Centre, seeking modification of the September 2006 judgment in the Prakash Singh case. It was pointed out to the court that its order had not been implemented by states and union territories after 12 years.

Attorney General KK Venugopal told the bench only five states—Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Rajasthan—had implemented the court's 2006 order. He said some state governments appointed their "favourite" officers as DGPs just before their retirement to give them extension while some others appointed acting DGPs.

"There is no concept of acting DGPs," the bench commented.

In its 2006 order, the top court had ordered separation of police functions of investigation and maintaining law and order; setting up of a Police Establishment Board to deal with transfers, postings, promotions and other service-related matters of officers up to the rank of DSP; Police Complaints Authority in each state to look into complaints against officers of and above the rank of SP in cases of serious misconduct.

A National Security Commission needed to be set up at the Centre to prepare a panel for selection and placement of chiefs of the Central Police Organizations with a minimum tenure of two years, it had directed.
